## Thursday 12th August:

- 18.30 – **Evening activity at the river Emån, Ruda;** swim in the river, take a bath in an outdoor heated wooden bathtub, entertainment and snacks. Beverages are supplied at self expense, the rest is included in the program.

\* On August 12th, the schools have not opened yet. However, pre-schools and out-of-school activities are running as normal. A visit will give an impression of how basic education is organized in Sweden.

### Glassworks and “hyttsill” in Nybro

Hyttsill is an old tradition which goes back to the times when the glassworks were the meeting place of the village. Food was prepared in the furnaces where the glass had been put in for gently cooling down during the night. Music entertainment and glass blowing. Contact persons from the different municipalities in Southeast Sweden will be present, so a perfect opportunity for meeting everyone!
